## Economic Incentive Rate Statement

A customer receiving an Economic Development Incentive (EDI) or Economic Development Zone Incentive (EDZI) for kilowatt-hour (kWh) usage attributable to load qualified on or after July 1, 2003, will have its service bills reduced by the following incentive rate per kWh, for all qualified kWhs:
