### Basic Local Exchange Service Credit

#### Basic Local Exchange Service Credit

In December of 2003, the Commission directed the Company to record certain Universal Service Funds (USF) proceeds related to a 1998 ice storm in a deferred credit account (The "USF-ICE Storm Proceeds"), for future disposition by the Commission. In September of 2012, the Company received approval to increase its rates by \$2.00 for one year as part the Framework for Regulatory Relief. The Company will apply the USF-ICE Storm Proceeds, in part, to offset basic local exchange rate increases for all customers.

The Company will issue the following monthly credit for each residential line as follows:
