Basic Local Exchange Service Credit

In December of 2003, the Commission directed the Company to record certain Universal Service Funds (USF) proceeds related to a 1998 ice storm in a deferred credit account (the "USF-Ice Storm Proceeds"), for future disposition by the Commission. In September of 2010, the Company received approval to increase its rates by \$2.00 for one year as part of the Framework for Regulatory Relief. The Company will apply the USF-Ice Storm Proceeds, in part, to offset basic local exchange rate increases for all customers. The company will issue the following monthly credit for each residential line as follows:
