II) Statement of Billing Rates in Effect

Pursuant to Service Classification No. 12 of National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation's P.S.C. No. 8 - Gas tariff, and the maximum allowable and minimum allowable rates identified above, the Company establishes the following SC 12 Standby Sales Service Rates ("SBSSR") effective February 1, 2020. SBSSR(1) - Default Rate
