System Benefits Charge Statement

Pursuant to Surcharge to Collect System Benefits Charge (“SBC”), General Information Rule 4 of Schedule PSC No. 120 - Electricity, the following SBC, which is comprised of three components, is applicable to all energy delivered [all kilowatt-hours (kWhs)] under the service classifications listed below, other than as specified below:

Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, and 14	Charge All kWh, per kWh
a. System Benefits Charge (Clean Energy Fund)	\$0.004858
b. System Benefits Charge (EE Tracker)	\$0.000924
c. CES Tier 2 Maintenance and Backstop Charge*	\$0.000000

Kilowatt-hours supplied by NYPA pursuant to Rule 10, Economic Development Power, Rule 11, Recharge New York (“RNY”) Power Program, and Rule 12, New Allocations of NYPA Power, are exempt from the System Benefits Charge.

*The NYPA exemption does not apply to this surcharge.
