The average cost of gas per therm (as defined on Leaf Nos. 17 - 17-A) determined on June 25, 1999 by applying the rates and charges of the Company's gas suppliers which will have been in effect not less than fifteen days prior to the date the gas adjustment becomes effective to the quantities of gas delivered to the Company's own Customers during the twelve months ended May 31, 1999, plus the costs associated with non-firm gas supplies is 33.0837 cents
2. Base Cost of Gas
The base cost of gas per therm is 30.0000 cents
3. Difference (Line 1 - Line 2) 3.0837 cents
