NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING**

**ATTACHMENT TO DRAFT NOTICE**

***Proposed action:*** The New York State Public Service Commission is considering whether to approve or reject, in whole or in part, proposed tariff revision to its tariff schedule, PSC No. 90 – Gas Service, filed by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) to become effective on June 1, 2024.

***Subject of rule:*** Proposed revisions to tariff schedule.

***Purpose of rule:*** The Company is filing a revision to its tariff to extend the period of time used in the calculation of the Loss Factor for the Company’s Lost and Unaccounted For Gas from five years to ten years.

***Substance of proposed rule:*** The New York State Public Service Commission is whether to approve or reject, in whole or in part, proposed tariff revision submitted by NYSEG that would allow for calculating NYSEG’s Loss Factor based on a ten-year average instead of the current five-year average. In using a ten-year average, while the Company’s Loss Factor would still remain relatively low, the result is not 0%, as it is in the calculation using a five-year average. Additionally, the calculation for the System Performance Adjustment would have an upper dead band in the event of a positive loss factor calculation.
