Dear Mr. Varley:

This letter is in response to LIWC's DSIC surcharge filing received on May 23, 2011, in accordance with the terms of the Joint Proposal (JP) approved by the Commission in Case 07-W-0508.

The company's submission shows that LIWC incurred a total capital cost of \$1,648,324 for water main, hydrant and service line replacements and capitalized water main repairs during the six month period October 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011. In accordance with the terms of the JP, \$838,593 of this amount qualifies to be recovered through the DSIC surcharge mechanism. This DSIC filing also includes an annual reconciliation between authorized and actual collections related to the DSIC surcharge. The result of the reconciliation was an undercollection of \$109,663, which is included in the calculation for the updated DSIC surcharge. Subsequent to discussions with Staff, the company submitted a revised surcharge calculation based on 12 months of projected metered revenue versus the calculation in the original filing, which was based on 8 months of projected metered revenue. Staff has completed its review of the company's revised submission and finds that the company proposal to recover an additional 0.47% surcharge, for an updated total surcharge of 2.44%, from all metered customers is proper.

The company, therefore, should file Distribution System Improvement Charge Statement No. 6, as described in the JP, to become effective July 22, 2011.
