## To: Municipalities and Water Districts Receiving Water From the Water Supply System of the City of New York

Please be advised that at the Special Meeting of the New York City Water Board held on Thursday, June 26, 2008, the Board approved an increase in the rate charged for water provided by the Water Supply System of the City of New York to customers outside of New York City.

Effective July 1,2008, the rate for water sales which do not exceed the allowance quantities of water authorized to each municipal corporation or water district pursuant to $\S 24-360$ of the Administrative Code of the City of New York shall be increased from $\$ 798.62$ per million gallons to $\$ 900.31$ per million gallons.

Effective July 1, 2008, the uniform metered water rate which applies to water sales which exceed the allowance quantities of water authorized to each municipal corporation or water district pursuant to $\S 24-360$ of the Administrative Code of the City of New York shall be increased from $\$ 2,700.53$ per million gallons to $\$ 3,088.24$ per million gallons.
