# 6.3 Local Number Portability (LNP)

# 6.3.1 <u>Description</u>

LNP is an intelligent network function that allows a Customer the ability to keep an existing phone number while changing telecommunications service providers. The exchanges mirror those of Verizon, and are detailed in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG).

### 6.3.2 Regulations

- A. A customer must keep the same address where they currently receive service or if a customer is moving to a new location, the new service address must be within the same rate center as the old service address. The exchanges mirror those of Verizon, and are detailed in the Local Exchange Routing Guide.
- B. The customer must keep the same level of service (DID, Ti, etc.) that they had with the previous service provider.
