SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS (CONT'D.)

2.5 Allowances for Interruptions in Service

2.5.1 General

Interruptions in service which are not due to the negligence of or noncompliance with the provisions of this tariff by, the Customer or the operation or malfunction of the facilities, power, or equipment provided by the Customer, will be credited to the Customer according to provisions set forth within this tariff for the part of the service that the interruption affects. The credit allowance will be calculated by the Company after the Customer notifies the Company of service interruption. The amount of the allowance will depend on the length of the outage and the service impacted.
