## 2.2 Obligations of the Customer (Cont'd.)

## 2.2.6 Prohibited Uses

The services VT offers shall not be used for any unlawful purposes or for any use as to which the Customer has not obtained all required governmental approvals, authorizations, licenses, consents and permits.

VT may require applicants for service who intend to use VT's offerings for resale and/or for shared use to file a letter with VT confirming that their use of VT's offerings complies with relevant laws and applicable state regulations, policies, orders, arid decisions, and if the Reseller intends to provide intrastate services, is certified with the appropriate state entity.

VT has the right to refuse telephone service to any premises and at any time to discontinue service, if it finds it necessary to do so to protect itself against intentional abuse. Intentional abuse of service includes, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the use of service or facilities of V T to transmit a message or to locate a person or otherwise to give or obtain information, without payment of a message toll charge or an exchange service charge. Another form of such abuse is an intentional uninterrupted connection of one exchange station to another station, excluding those connections charged on an elapsed time basis, which permits the use of the facilities in a manner similar to private line service. It also includes intentional receiver Off Hook conditions.
