SPECIAL PROVISIONS: (Cont'd.)

m. C.A.\$H.BACK Special Provision:

The Company will provide a voluntary program for load normally supplied and delivered by NYSEG, for eligible customers to curtail load. NYSEG's program, entitled C.A.\$H.BACK, implements the NYISO's day-ahead economic load-curtailement program. Under this program, a customer agrees to curtail load when their bid is submitted and accepted by the NYISO.

Customers who are qualified under C.A.\$H.BACK in Section 21 of the General Information section of this Schedule may participate in the NYSEG C.A.\$H.BACK Program as set forth therein.

n. Farm Waste Electric Generating System Option:

This option is for a customer qualifying for the Farm Waste Electric Generating System Option pursuant to General Information Section 22 of this Schedule, and taking service under SC 2.

o. Wind Electric Service Option:

This option is for a customer qualifying for the Wind Electric Service Option pursuant to General Information Section 23 of this Schedule and taking service under SC 2.

p. Fuel Cell Electric Service Option:

This option is for a customer qualifying for the Fuel Cell Service Option pursuant to General Information Section 30 of this Schedule and taking service under SC 2.

q. Micro-Hydroelectric Service Option:

This option is for a customer qualifying for the Micro-Hydroelectric Service Option pursuant to General Information Section 31 of this Schedule and taking service under SC 2.
