**3.3 Responsibility of the Telephone Company**

| <b>3.3.5 Termination for Cause Other Than Nonpayment</b> |  |

| <b>A.</b>  | Subject to PSC NY No. 900, the Telephone Company may terminate the furnishing of a channel, for any of the following reasons. <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In the event of prohibited or improper use of the facilities, or any other violation by the subscriber of the rules and regulations governing the facilities furnished.</li><li>2. Upon objection to their continuance made by or on behalf of any governmental authority.</li><li>3. If, in the judgment of the Telephone Company, any use of the facilities by the subscriber tends to injuriously affect the efficiency of the Telephone Company's plant, property, or service.</li><li>4. Upon the use of any of the facilities for the purpose of performing any service which the Telephone Company or the Associated Companies may now or hereafter perform.</li></ol> |
