GENERAL RULES

10. Meter Reading and Billing - Continued

10.5 Proration of Monthly Rates and Charges

Where the Company renders a bill for other than a 30 day period, the rates and charges will be prorated, unless otherwise specified, on the basis of the number of elapsed days divided by 30; except that a Customer who terminates service less than 30 days after the commencement of service, will be billed for a month.

Rates and charges stated without reference to a specific month shall apply to all electric service supplied hereunder on and after the effective date hereof. Where a bill includes periods before the effective date and after the effective date, the rates and charges applicable will be prorated based on the number of days of service rendered before the effective date and on and after the effective date related to the total number of days in the billing period.

Rates and charges referable to a specific month (“month-specific rates and charges”) shall apply to all electric service supplied hereunder after the last day of the preceding month and through the last day of the named month. Where a bill includes periods before and after the first calendar day of a month, the month-specific rates and charges applicable will be prorated based on the number of days of service rendered before the first day of the month and on and after the first calendar day of the month related to the total number of days in the billing period.

The Billing and Payment Processing Charge will not be prorated for periods greater or less than 30 days.

As-Used Daily Demand Delivery Charges applicable under Standby Service rates and their associated Monthly Adjustment Charges will not be prorated.
