11.1 Access Services, (Cont'd.)

11.1.2 Rate Elements

A. Non-Recurring Charges: Non-Recurring charges are applied as a one-time fee normally at the time the circuit is initiated.

- B. Monthly Recurring Charges: Monthly recurring charges are billed monthly in advance and are assessed based on capacity (e.g. DS1 or DS3) and the terms and conditions of this tariff, the Customer Service Agreement, or a Master Service Agreement.
- C. Entrance Facility/Channel Termination Charge: The Entrance Facility/Channel Termination provides the transmission path between the Primary Distribution Node and the Serving Wire Center (SWC) of the Primary Distribution Node. These charges apply when the Customer utilizes Company facilities to access the Primary Distribution Node.
- D. Direct-Trunked Transport: Direct-Trunked Transport provides the transmission path between the SWC of the Customer's facilities, or other point of interconnection, and the Company's Primary Distribution Node. This charge applies when the Customer utilizes Company facilities to transport traffic from the Customer's SWC, or other point of interconnection, to the Primary Distribution Node.
 - 1. Fixed Mileage Charge: The fixed mileage charge is a recurring monthly fee which is applied to a circuit for which the LEC would charge a comparable fee in association with an interoffice channel.
 - 2. Variable Mileage Charge: Variable mileage charge is a recurring monthly fee which is applied to a circuit for which the LEC would charge a comparable fee in association with an interoffice channel. In general, the variable mileage charge is calculated using V&H tables.
