E. ESCO or DC Participation: (Cont'd.)

9. Scheduling, Balancing and Settlement:

(a) The following applies to scheduling, balancing and settlement with the NYISO:

- i. ESCOs/DCs will schedule Electric Power Supply directly with the NYISO.
- ii. NYSEG will calculate customer load including NYSEG System Losses and UFE, by hour, and combine accounts by ESCO/DC and by subzone.
- iii. NYSEG will adjust the sum of all ESCO/DC load so that the hourly usage equals the NYISO-supplied subzone loads.
- iv. NYSEG will communicate the hourly load calculations to the NYISO, in accordance with the NYISO's Billing Schedule requirements for true-ups.
- v. The NYISO will balance those hourly load calculations with the ESCO/DC bulk power deliveries, price the imbalance, and invoice or credit the ESCO/DC for the cost of the imbalance.

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
