ACCESS SERVICE

3. CARRIER COMMON LINE ACCESS SERVICE

The Telephone Company will provide Carrier Common Line Access Service (Carrier Common Line Access) to customers.

3.1 General Description

Carrier Common Line Access provides for the use of Telephone Company common lines by customers for access to end users to furnish customer intrastate communications.

Carrier Common Line Access is provided where the customer obtains Telephone Company Switched Access Service under this tariff.

Premium Access is (1) Switched Access Service provided to ICs under this tariff which furnish intrastate MTS/WATS, (2) Switched Access Service in an end office converted to equal access (3) Switched Access Service provided to customers as 800 Access Service and (4) Switched Access Service provided to customers as 900 Access Service.

Non-Premium Access is Switched Access Service provided in an end office not yet converted to equal access to customers that do not furnish intrastate MTS/WATS, 800 Service or 900 Service.

3.2 Limitations

- (A) A telephone number is not provided with Carrier Common Line Access.
