## 1.3.2 Definitions (Cont'd.)

<u>Call</u> - A LEC attempt for which the complete address code (e.g., 7 or 10 digits) is provided to the serving dial tone office.

<u>Carrier Identification Code</u> - A three or four digit number used by the Telephone Company to provide terminating local exchange service access to a LEC and implement appropriate measurement capabilities associated with LEC switched services.

<u>Central Office</u> - A local Telephone Company switching system where telephone exchange service customer station loops are terminated for purposes of interconnection to each other and to trunks.

<u>Central Office Prefix</u> - The first three digits (NXX) of the seven digit telephone number assigned to a end user's telephone exchange service when dialed on a local basis.

<u>Centralized Message Data Systems Host</u> - An existing telephone company with already established ownership on the national CMDS network necessary for intercompany settlements.

<u>Channel(s)</u> - An electrical or photonic, in the case of fiber optic-based transmission systems, communications path between two or more points of termination.

<u>Common Channel Signaling Access</u> - The capability which allows LECs access to the Telephone Company SS7 signaling network.

<u>Eligible LEC</u> - An authorized full service facilities-based provider of local exchange services designated as such by Order of the PSC. The Telephone Company is considered an eligible LEC for this purpose. A LEC may be considered partially eligible under this tariff.
