REGULATIONS

2.1 CONTRACT SERVICE ARRANGEMENTS

Customer-specific contract service arrangements may be furnished in lieu of existing Tariff offerings.

- 2.1.1 Rates, charges, term, and additional regulations, if applicable, for the contract service arrangement shall be developed on an individual case basis.
- 2.1.2 Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for contract service arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and rates specified in this tariff.

2.2 TERMINAL EQUIPMENT

Service may be used with or terminated in Customer-provided terminal equipment. Such terminal equipment shall be furnished by and maintained at the expense of the Customer, except as otherwise provided. The Customer is also responsible for all costs it incurs in the use of service, including but not limited to equipment, wiring, electrical power, and personnel. When such terminal equipment is used, it shall in all respects comply with the generally accepted minimum protective standards of the telecommunications industry as endorsed by the Federal Communications Commission.

2.3 INSPECTION, TESTING AND ADJUSTMENT

- 2.3.1 The Company may, upon reasonable notice, make such tests and inspections as may be necessary to determine whether tariff requirements are being complied with in the installation, operation, and maintenance of the Customer's or the Company's equipment. The Company may, without notice, interrupt service at any time, as necessary, because of a departure from any of these requirements and may continue such interruption until its requirements have been satisfied.
- 2.3.2 Upon reasonable notice, the facilities provided by the Company shall be made available to the Company by the Customer for such tests and adjustments as may be necessary for their maintenance to a condition satisfactory to the Company.
- 2.3.3 The Company shall not be liable to the Customer for any damages for service interruption pursuant to this Section.
