## 4.1.3 Regulations (Continued)

- Q. Administrative Charge - An administrative charge will be applied whenever a change is made, at Customer's request, to a Customer's Address Map. Such changes are defined as those rearrangements necessary to add, delete, or rearrange the configuration of an existing Address Map. Although multiple changes may be caused by such actions, only one administrative charge will apply. The administrative charge also applies for customer-requested changes to the bandwidth capacity of existing circuits (e.g., 384 Kbps to 1.536 Mbps, or 4 Mbps to 10 Mbps). However, if a customer upgrades between service levels (e.g., 384 Kbps to 4 Mbps) or downgrades between service levels (e.g., 10 Mbps to 1.536 Mbps) the nonrecurring service charge associated with the new service level applies.

The administrative charge applies per occurrence, per UNI Port With Access Line Connection, UNI Port Only Connection or NNI Port Only Connection.

## T. Waiver or Reduction of Charges and Promotions

1. In order to promote the sale of Frame Relay Service, the Company reserves the right to waive or reduce recurring monthly rates, or nonrecurring charges, or both, or to offer promotional rates for recurring monthly rates or nonrecurring charges or both, at any time upon seven days' notice to the Commission.
2. Waivers, reductions and promotional rates in effect are listed in the Attachment to this Section.
3. Each waiver, reduction or promotion will not extend beyond 90 days.
4. Appropriate notification of the waiver, reduction or promotion will be made to affected customers.
