4.3.11 Termination Liability (Cont'd)

C. Prior to the end of the term commitment period, the Customer may select one of the following options, to be effective at the end of the term:

1. Renew their term commitment,
2. Commit to a new term period,
3. Arrange for a change of service, or
4. Arrange for termination of the service.

In the event the Customer does not select one of the above options, the Customer will be converted to the shortest-term period available under tariff (i.e., one-year term, etc.) for the same service and will be subject to the applicable term commitment, if any, unless the Customer terminates the service within sixty (60) days of the conversion date.

D. Early termination charges will not be assessed under the following circumstances:

1. Customer moves existing service to a new location within the same address and/or same building (inside move) and maintains that service for the remainder of the term;
2. Customer renegotiates a new term commitment plan for the same service before the current term commitment expires and the value of the new term commitment is equal to or greater than the remaining value of the current term commitment; or
3. Customer changes or upgrades to another service that is provided by the Company or its affiliates under a term commitment, provided the following conditions are met:
 - a. The revenue value to the Company or its affiliates of the new term commitment is equal to or greater than the remaining value of the current term commitment; and
 - b. The order to discontinue the existing service and the order for the new or upgraded service are received by the Company or its affiliates at the same time.
