3. The CLEC is required to provide sufficient terminating facilities and service at the terminating end of a forwarded call to adequately handle all traffic to that location and is solely responsible to ensure that its facilities, equipment and services do not interfere with or impair any facility, equipment or service of the Company or any of its end users.
4. End to end transmissions characteristics may vary depending on the distance and routing necessary to complete calls over facilities and the fact that another CLEC is involved in provisioning of service.
5. The Company will pay the CLEC the appropriate POTS Traffic termination rates (reference Section 5.1.6) for all redirected calls.
6. The regulations herein are in addition to the terms and conditions specified in the Switched Access Services tariff.
7. Nothing in this language shall preclude an alternative mutually agreed upon arrangement, including an arrangement in which access charges are forwarded for calls that originate in another LATA or on intraLATA access services via presubscription.
