 - ISDN-BRI Service will be furnished at the rates contained in this Section of the g. tariff, provided that necessary facilities are available. Where necessary facilities are not available or unusual expenditures are involved in making them available, the customer may be required to pay additional charges for the unusual expenditure, to contract for services beyond the service term, or both, Individual case billing arrangements can be developed at the discretion of the Company Lines, equipment and facilities provided under this tariff will be designed by the Telephone Company to provide at least the same level of service, reliability, and quality as local exchange service in the exchanges where ISDN-BRI Service is offered. At a minimum, ISDN-BRI Service will be provided where the access line does not exceed 14 kilofeet in length from the customer's premises to the serving central office, or experience a maximum loss of 34 dB as measured at the customer's premises at no additional cost to the customer. For circumstances that exceed these minimum service standards, special construction charges may be applied.
 - h. The Telephone Company may make changes in its telecommunications services, equipment, operations, or procedures, where such action is consistent with Part 68 of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules and Regulations. If such changes materially affect the operating characteristics or technical parameters of the service as originally ordered by the customer, adequate notice will be given in writing to allow the customer an opportunity to maintain uninterrupted service.
