RIDER L - DIRECT LOAD CONTROL PROGRAM - Continued

C. Definitions - Continued

An “Event” may be declared by the Company when:

1. the next contingency on the Company’s system would result in a Condition Yellow or a voltage reduction of five percent or greater has been ordered. A Condition Yellow exists when the next contingency (excluding breaker failure) either will result in an outage to more than 15,000 customers or will result in some equipment being loaded above emergency ratings; or
2. the Company’s forecasted load level is at least 96 percent of the forecasted summer system-wide peak or specific network peak.

“Load Relief Period” exists when an Event has been declared by the Company. The Company may designate specific networks, feeders or geographical areas in which Load Relief will be requested.

D. Applications

Applications to participate under this Rider may be made throughout the year either electronically or in writing. Applications will be accepted until annual program costs (e.g., equipment, installation, maintenance, and payments made to Customers) reach \$10 million.
