(2) Business Plans

A business customer may subscribe to one of three sets of discount packages to be applied to charges from their Home Region to another particular Region. The discount will be in an amount commensurate with the package selected. Additional usage beyond the plan selected will be discounted at the same rate. Any fraction beyond the additional use rate will be charged at the additional use amount.

For Rates and Charges, see Section 7.2 of this Tariff.

c. Regulations

- (1) A record order charge as shown in Tariff PSC NY No. 1--COMMUNICATIONS, Section 30.14, will apply to establish ECP Service, except when it is established with the connection of telephone service or within 75 days thereof.
- (2) A record order charge does not apply to a change from one Plan to another, but does apply when changing a Plan from one Region to another.
- (3) Each discount package subscribed to by the customer covers usage only from the Home Region to the one particular Region selected.
- (4) A customer may subscribe to more than one plan as long as it pertains to a different Region.
- (5) The local call allowance where applicable to residence message rate service does not apply to ECONOPATH Calling Plan Service.
- (6) Local calls to Regions other than those subscribed to under ECP Service are charged for at standard tariff rates.
- (7) Evening and Night rate period discounts apply to calls in the plans.
- (8) ECP Service is furnished for a minimum period of one month.
