# (A) Local Transport (Cont'd)

The Telephone Company will provide end users with access to operators of a customer for operator interLATA or intraLATA assisted call completion when only 0- is dialed by the end user. The customer will be assessed an Operator Passthrough charge that will include the costs associated with handling the operator services traffic: 1) If the customer (or a carrier designated by the customer) provides operator services for end users for calls originating from a particular LATA and is capable of receiving calls passed through to it in that LATA by the Telephone Company, and 2) if the customer does not provide operator services as specified above and the Telephone Company routes the 0- call to a Telephone Company provided recording. Operator Passthrough Service is only available in end offices equipped with Feature Group D. The Operator Passthrough charge is set forth in 30.6.1(C) following. The application of this rate is as set forth in 6.7.1(D) following.

The Telephone Company will, when specifically requested by an end user, connect that end user to a specified customer for operator call completion provided that customer offers operator services in the end user's originating LATA and is capable of receiving calls passed through to it by the Telephone Company in that LATA.

Operator Passthrough Service is provided on a mechanized and manual basis for interLATA and intraLATA calls.

0- Operator Passthrough regulations and rates apply only to Verizon New York.

Local Transport and the CCSA option are provided at the rates and charges set forth in 30.6.1 following. The application of these rates with respect to individual Feature Groups is as set forth in 6.7.1(D), 6.7.1(E) and 6.7.1(I) following.

CCSA is comprised of a STP Link Termination rate, a STP Link Transport rate and a STP Port rate. The application of the STP Port rate is set forth in (B) following.

The STP Link Termination rate provides for the connection from the customer designated premises to the serving wire center.
