The time when the connection is established, determined in accordance with the time (standard or daylight saving) legally in use at the point where the calling station is located, determines whether day, evening or night rates apply.

Where usage begins in one rate period and ends in another, the rates in effect for the rate period in which such usage began will apply unless the local exchange carrier implements actual rate period billing, i.e., split rate period billing. When split rate period billing is available, usage which begins in one rate period and ends in another will be billed at the rates applicable to each such rate period.
