**TARIFF FORMAT**

- A. Leaf Numbering** – Leaf numbers appear in the upper right corner of the Leaf. Leafs are numbered sequentially. However, new leafs are occasionally added to the Tariff. When a new leaf is added between Leafs already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new leaf added between leafs 14 and 15 would be 14.1.
- B. Leaf Revision Numbers** – Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each leaf. These numbers are used to determine the most current leaf version on file with the New York PSC. For example, the 4th Revised Leaf 14 supersedes the 3rd Revised Leaf 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc., that the Commission follows in its tariff approval process, the most current leaf number on file with the Commission is not always the tariff leaf in effect.
- C. Paragraph Numbering Sequence** – There are nine levels of paragraph coding. Each level of coding is subservient to its next higher level:

  - 2.1.
  - 2.1.1.
  - 2.1.1.A.
  - 2.1.1.A.1.
  - 2.1.1.A.1.(a).
  - 2.1.1.A.1.(a).I.
  - 2.1.1.A.1.(a).I.(i).
  - 2.1.1.A.1.(a).I.(i).(1).
