SECTION 3 – DESCRIPTION OF SWITCHED SERVICES

3.9 Grandfathered Services (continued)

3.9.13 Business Long Distance 50 Connections 1 Service<sup>1</sup>

- (A) Business Long Distance 50 Connections 1 Service is a custom combination switched TFS, outbound, and calling card Flat Rate Service available to Business 7Customers that:
- .1 request to be provisioned under this Service;
  - .2 utilize Switched Access to reach the long distance network for outbound calling and/or utilize Switched Access to receive calls from the long distance network for TFS;
  - .3 subscribe to a minimum of two Centrex station lines from a AT&T Affiliate, or, a minimum of two Centrex station lines from a AT&T Affiliate, or, a minimum of one business access line under a term agreement from a AT&T Affiliate, or, a Business Solutions<sup>SM</sup>, CompleteLink<sup>®</sup>, SimpleLink, Plexar I<sup>®</sup>, Centrex with Classic Feature Package<sup>SM</sup>, Pacific Bell Instant Office<sup>SM</sup>, Power Office, The Business Plan, Custom Biz Saver<sup>SM</sup>, Local Usage Saver<sup>SM</sup> or Ameritech Centrex Service (ACS) service package as defined in Section 1 of this Tariff or, subscribe to all of the following from an AT&T Affiliate:
    - .a a minimum of one business access line, and,
    - .b an inside wire maintenance product associated with each business access line, and,
    - .c at least one instance of Caller ID, and,
    - .d at least one instance of each of any three call control features from Group D Package as defined in Section 1 of this Tariff from a AT&T Affiliate.
  - .4 demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Company at the time of subscribing to the Service that the Customer also subscribes to the products or services described in Section 3.7.25 (A).3 of this Tariff;
