A. **DEFINITIONS**

Daily Delivery Quantity (DDQ) - The total daily quantity of gas grossed up for UFG the Seller is required by the Company to deliver each day to the Company's city gate to serve the estimated gas consumption of the Seller's Pool . Such quantity shall be determined at least monthly by the Company and is subject to the limitations, restrictions, and other provisions contained herein.

Capacity Release - Interstate pipeline transportation capacity released by the Company to Seller or Seller's Agent in accordance with FERC regulations and the tariffs of the interstate pipelines.

Energy Service Company (ESCO) - An entity eligible to sell natural gas to the Company's transportation customers served under Service Classification Nos. 17 and 18. ESCOs may also sell other energy supplies and energy related services to customers.

Gas Year – The 12-month period beginning November 1st and ending October 31st of each year.

GTOP Manual – Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual.

Load Factor – The ratio of : 1) the average daily normalized annual consumption of the Seller's Pool to 2) the estimated peak day consumption of the Seller's Pool.

Marketer – A person or entity eligible to sell natural gas to the Company's transportation customers served under Service Classification Nos. 17 and 18.
