- (b) If it is necessary to install a transformer to provide Outdoor Lighting service, the customer is responsible for the cost of the transformer as well as installation costs. Lamp replacement and repairs will be made only during regular working hours, Monday through Friday. Customers that request the installation of glare shields will be responsible for the costs associated with such installation, consistent with Section 6 of PSC No. 119, Charges For Special Services.
- (c) Any customer-owned pole on which a lamp is to be mounted or to which wire is to be attached must be approved by the Corporation. If a customer-owned pole on which such equipment is mounted deteriorates, is damaged, or has its use impaired so that it no longer is approved by the Corporation, service may be terminated.
