## SECTION 2 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS, (Cont'd.)

## 2.3 Limitations of Service

- 2.3.4 The Company reserves the right to refuse to process Third Party Billed calls when the Company determines the billed party and/or standard validation techniques do not confirm acceptance, or based on characteristics of the originating or terminating location that such billing may not be authorized.
- 2.3.5 The Company reserves the right to refuse to process Travel Card or Calling Card billed calls when authorization for use of the card cannot be validated or to prevent the unlawful use of service. The Customer may be required to provide an acceptable alternate billing method or the Company may refuse to place the call.
