28. Surcharge to Collect Temporary State Assessment ("TSAS")

All Energy Charges and Demand Charges, if applicable, for Delivery Service under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, and 14 will be increased to collect a Temporary State Energy and Utility Service Conservation Assessment pursuant to the Commission's *Order Implementing Temporary State Assessment*, issued June 19, 2009.

Unless prohibited by contract, the surcharge will be applied to all kWh and KW, as applicable, on the customer bill, including usage subject to Economic Incentives and kWh's supplied by NYPA.

A Temporary State Assessment Surcharge (TSAS) Statement setting forth the surcharges by service classification will be filed with the Public Service Commission on not less than fifteen (15) days' notice. Such statement can be found at the end of this Schedule (PSC 120 – Electricity).
