- A. Qwest Prepaid Card Service
 - 4. Credit Allowances for Interruptions (Cont'd)
 - c. Credit allowances are not issued for interruptions that are due to the failure of power, equipment or systems not provided by the Company, or for interruptions which are not properly reported to the Company.

5. Recharging Feature

- a. Customers may increase a Prepaid Card balance using a valid commercial credit card which is accepted by the Company. This feature is only available to holders of unexpired cards and such transactions must be handled through a Qwest provided telephone number and representative.
- b. All additional Prepaid Card units or dollars will be charged to the cardholder at the prevailing tariffed rate in effect on the date of recharging.
- c. A minimum of 30 units must be purchased in order to take advantage of the recharge feature.
- 6. Taxes and Other Charges
 - a. Taxes

Charges for Qwest Prepaid Card Service are inclusive of federal, state and local taxes imposed on the provision of telecommunications service, but exclusive of the general retail sales, use and other similar taxes that may be imposed on the sale of the Qwest Prepaid Card at the time and point-of-sale.
