INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE TARIFF 11. OBSOLETE TRAVEL SERVICES

11.1 GENERAL

- A. This section sets forth the rates and charges applicable to the Company's Obsolete Travel Service offerings. These services are no longer offered to new customers however, existing customers will be allowed to retain their obsolete service only as long as they remain at the same location for the same customer. The total charge for each completed operator assisted call consists of the following charge elements:
 - 1. A one-time fixed operator service charge added to the first minute of each operator service call, which will be dependent on the type of billing selected (i.e., Calling Card, Third Party), and/or the completion restriction selected (i.e., Person-to-Person);
 - 2. A usage charge dependent on the duration, distance, and time of day of the call. The usage charge element is specified as duration, with a minimum charge for each call of one minute, and with fractional minutes of use thereafter counted as full minutes;
 - 3. Other additional surcharges as provided herein (i.e., payphone surcharge, non-subscriber surcharge, location surcharge or other).
- B. The following section sets forth the rates and charges for intrastate telecommunications services provided by the Company. All services are offered subject to the availability of facilities.
