1.4.5 CHECK SHEETS

Whenever the tariff is revised, an updated check sheet will be issued. The check sheet lists the leafs contained in the tariff, with a cross-reference to the current revision number. When new leafs are added, the check sheet is changed to reflect the revision. All revisions made in a given filing are designated by an asterisk (*). There will be no other symbols used on the check sheet if these are the only changes made to it (i.e., the format, etc., remains the same). The tariff user should refer to the latest check sheet to find out if a particular leaf is the most current on file.

1.4.6 EXPLANATION OF CHANGE SYMBOLS

When changes are made in any tariff leaf, a revised leaf will be issued canceling the tariff leaf affected. Changes will be identified on the revised leaf through the use of the following symbols.
