**1.4 TARIFF FORMAT (Cont'd)**

**1.4.3 RATE TABLES**

Within rate tables, four types of entries are allowed:

- Rate Amount

The rate amount indicates the dollar value associated with the service.

- A dash "-"

The dash indicates that there is no rate for the service or that a rate amount is not applicable under the specific column header.

- A footnote designator "[1]"

The footnote designator indicates that further information is contained in a footnote.

**1.4.4 LEAF NUMBERS**

**A. Leaf Number**

1. Leaf numbers appear in the upper right corner of the leaf. Leafs are numbered sequentially. When a new leaf is added between leafs already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new leaf added between Leaf 14 and 15 would be 14.1.

**B. Leaf Revision Numbers**

1. Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each leaf. These numbers are used to determine the most current leaf version on file. For example, the 4th revised Leaf 14 cancels the 3rd revised Leaf 14.
