## 2.2 ESTABLISHING AND FURNISHING SERVICE

## 2.2.15 ALLOWANCE FOR INTERRUPTIONS (Cont'd)

- E. For services which are subject to a monthly recurring charges, allowances for interruptions will be determined as follows:
  - 1. When service is interrupted for a period of less than two hours, no credit allowance will be given;
  - 2. When the service is interrupted for a period of two to twenty-four hours, the amount of the credit allowance shall not exceed one-thirtieth (1/30) of the monthly recurring charge or charges for the circuit; or
  - 3. When the service is interrupted for a period over twenty-four hours, the amount of the credit allowance shall not exceed one-thirtieth (1/30) of the monthly recurring charge or charges for the circuit multiplied by the number of twenty four hour periods during which the service was interrupted.
- F. Allowances for Interruptions shall be included in a subsequent monthly invoice. The amount of the credit allowance shall be determined by the Company and shall in no event not exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge for the period during which the service is interrupted. In no event shall usage charges be eligible for Allowances for Interruptions.
