Y. Optional Calling Plan - Residence

1. General Description

Optional Calling Plan is a service arrangement that enables subscribers or authorized users to charge long-distance calls to an authorized calling card account. Calls can be completed between any two points within the state. Calls are initiated by using access code dialing and authorized codes. Optional Calling Plan is direct billed and available to subscribers for retention and/or return of service to Quest. A monthly fee will be applied beginning with the subscriber's first invoice. Service is available on a full-time basis, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

2. Rates and Charges

Billing will be done in initial sixty-second increments and additional sixty-second increments.
