(3) Installation of Service

The Company, upon proper application, will tap the main and provide the corporation curb cock and in addition install the service pipe from the main to the property line at its own expense. The size of the service pipe and the materials to be used shall be determined by the Company.

That portion of the service line without the territorial limits of any street, avenue, road or way that is used for highway purposes which is installed by the applicant at his expense must be approved by the Company before the trench is backfilled. No attachment to such pipe or any branch thereof shall be made between the meter and the main.

(4) Leakage from Customers Facilities

Whenever leakage occurs on pipes and facilities owned by the customer, the customer shall make the necessary repairs without delay. If the customer fails to make said repairs, the Company reserves the right to discontinue the supply until such time as the leak is repaired and all costs incurred by the Company are paid. Disconnection shall be accomplished in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 unless the provisions of Section 4.K apply.

F. Inspection and Examination of Utility Apparatus

(1) Right to Inspect

(a) An agent of the Company may enter, at all reasonable times, any location supplied with service by the Company for inspection and examination of its equipment related to the provision of such service.

(b) An agent of the Company may not enter locked premises without the permission of a person lawfully in control of the premises, unless explicitly authorized by court order or when an emergency may threaten the health or safety of a person, the surrounding area or the Company's distribution system.
