- 4. The Company may not terminate service unless:
 - (a) it has verified that payment has not been received at any office of the Company or at any office of an authorized collection agent through the end of the notice period required by this Part; and
 - (b) it has verified on the day termination is scheduled that payment has not been posted to the customer's account as of the opening of business on that day, or has complied with procedures established under paragraph E of this section.
- 5. The Company may not terminate service more than 60 calendar days after issuance of the final termination notice unless it has, during that time, issued a new termination notice that complies with paragraph (b) (1) of this section or has updated the original notice to include the current arrears.
