SECTION 6-OPTIONAL CALLING PLANS

6.33 AT&T UNLIMITED PLAN (BLKNP) (Cont'd)

6.33.2 RATES AND CHARGES

Eligible Dial Station intrastate long distance calls that are not placed to residential telephone lines that are subscribed to AT&T as the Primary Interexchange Carrier will be rated at a maximum rate of \$.21 (T) per minute all day, seven days a week. This includes, but is not limited to, calls to: telephone lines that are subscribed to a Primary Interexchange Carrier other than AT&T; on-line services or Internet access services; wireless devices (e.g., wireless phones or pagers); businesses; and subscribers to a business customer calling plan.

The monthly recurring charge applies whether or not a customer makes any calls. The monthly recurring charge is billed and payable in advance. Therefore, customers will have two monthly recurring charges on their first billing statement, one which applies to the billing month in which the customer enrolls in the plan, and one which applies to the next billing month.

In the event that a customer of AT&T Local Exchange Services as described in P.S.C. No. 24 subscribes to a local plan that provides an expanded local calling area, including intraLATA toll calls, then those intraLATA toll calls will be rated under the expanded local calling area plan. The AT&T Unlimited Plan will not apply to such intraLATA toll calls.

6.33.3 AVAILABILITY

If, at time of enrollment in this Plan, a customer selects AT&T as its primary carrier for intraLATA toll calls, the customer's intraLATA toll calls will be eligible under this Plan once the local telephone company has processed the customer's AT&T IntraLATA toll subscription. If, for any reason, a customer's election of AT&T as the primary carrier for intraLATA toll calls is not made or implemented, the monthly recurring charge for this Plan will still apply even though the customer will not receive the intraLATA toll call benefits of this Plan.
