## 5.3 Credit Allowance Conditions

## 5.3.1 Service Interruptions

- A. If service is interrupted, a pro rata allowance at the tariff rate for the facilities affected shall be made for the time such interruption continues after notice and demand to the Telephone Company, provided such interruption is not caused by the negligence or the willful act of the subscriber, or by failure of subscriber's power supply, or by testing and adjusting by the Telephone Company or by action of the subscriber in ascertaining an inoperative condition of the channel by his own means.
- 1. It shall be the obligation of the subscriber to give notice to the Telephone Company of any interruption of service. The subscriber will undertake to ascertain before giving notice to the Telephone Company that any such interruption of service is not caused by any action or omission or any other cause within the control of the subscriber. The Telephone Company shall not be obligated to take any action upon notice received from any source other than the subscriber.

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
