6. Channels for Television Transmission in Connection with Educational TV Systems**6.2 Application of Rates and Charges**

6.2.3 Moves	
A.	When existing equipment or channel terminations are moved to a new location in the same building or to a different building on the same premises, the following charges apply.
1.	Local Distribution Systems — Charges based on cost, not to exceed the applicable installation charge for the facilities moved.
2.	Interexchange Systems
a.	Option A — Payment of charges based on cost in lieu of termination charge.
b.	Option B — Payment of termination charges for the specific equipment. Service at the new location is subject to same treatment as initial installation.
B.	Other changes in location are classified as disconnections at the old location and as connections at the new location.

6.2.4 Local Distribution Systems	
A.	Rates and charges for headend equipment apply separately in each room where headend equipment for the system is located.
B.	At the subscriber's option, the distribution facilities in any two-point section of a local distribution system may be charged for at the monthly rate and termination charge applicable for an interexchange system of 25 miles airline for the appropriate number of channels in the interexchange system.
C.	Charges from Low VHF to High VHF Systems — The monthly rates for a high VHF system apply to all channels converted to a high VHF system.

6.2.5 Surcharges	
A.	Municipal Surcharge for Local Utility Gross Revenue Taxes — In certain cities and villages a municipal surcharge to recover the additional expense related to Local Utility Gross Revenue Taxes applies as specified in PSC NY No. 900.
B.	Metropolitan Commuter Transportation District Tax Surcharge — In the following counties, a surcharge to recover the additional expense related to the Temporary Metropolitan Transportation Business Tax Surcharge applies as specified in PSC NY No. 900.
1.	Bronx County
2.	Dutchess County
3.	Kings County
