6. Channels for Television Transmission in Connection with Educational TV Systems**6.2 Application of Rates and Charges**

6.2.1 Termination Charges	
A.	When the subscriber requests termination of an interexchange system, or any part thereof, within 120 months of the date service is established, or when the Telephone Company terminates such service within such period for any reason for which it may terminate such service, a termination charge applies.
1.	The termination charge is determined by applying the ratio of the unexpired portion of such 120 month period to the full 120 month period to the estimated installed and removal costs not covered by the installation charges less estimated recoverable salvage value, if any, of the facilities involved.
2.	The estimated installed and removal costs shall include the costs of all materials, supplies, engineering, labor, supervision, transportation, rights-of-way, interest during construction, taxes, general overhead, including appropriate loadings for such things as relief and pensions, social security taxes, vacations and sickness and any other items associated with the project which are chargeable to the Telephone Company's accounts under the uniform system of accounts applicable to the Telephone Company, and in addition thereto an amount to cover any gross revenue taxes imposed by the State of New York and/or any subdivision thereof with respect to such termination charges.

6.2.2 Mileage	
A.	Unless otherwise specified in this tariff, mileage where applicable to television channels, is measured airline between the terminal locations (rate centers where distance is 40 miles or over) in the manner which joins all locations and produces the lowest total rate. The mileage rate for each segment of such measurements is computed separately.
B.	Where the subscriber's requirements necessitate connecting signal source and receiving locations by means of specific routings, the mileage is measured airline in accordance with such specific routings.
C.	Where city blocks are established, the distance is measured to the center of the block in which the terminal of the channel is located. Where blocks are not established, the distance is measured to the center of the building in which the terminal is located.
D.	Where a terminal of the channel is located in the territory of the Rochester Telephone Corporation, mileage is measured to the point of connection with the facilities of the Rochester Telephone Corporation, in accordance with PSC NY No. 900.
