

Channels for Television Transmission

3. General Regulations
3.2 Use of Service

3.2.1 General	
A.	The channel facilities provided under the terms, conditions and charges of this tariff are the only channel facilities furnished by the Telephone Company for the transmission of television program material in connection with educational TV systems. Channels for television transmission in connection with educational TV systems may be interconnected and may be connected with other program or video channels, furnished by the Telephone Company, for transmission between points within New York State of television programs to the educational TV system and with antenna systems for pick-up of broadcast programs but may not be connected with other channels of the Telephone Company, the subscriber, or others, except as follows.
1.	The subscriber may provide the station wiring within a building beyond the termination of the Telephone Company's television channel facilities, or the Telephone Company will provide extensions of the television channel facilities to each classroom or other location within the building designated by the subscriber at applicable tariff rates.

3.2.2 Interference with Telephone Company Service or Other Parties	
A.	The magnitude and the character of the voltages and currents impressed on the channel by the subscriber-owned equipment and wiring and the operation and maintenance of such equipment and wiring shall be such as not to interfere with any of the services offered by the Telephone Company or interfere with others. The characteristics of the subscriber-owned apparatus shall be such that its connection to the channel does not interfere with service over other Telephone Company lines or channels or impair privacy of communication over such lines or channels.
1.	If, in the judgment of the Telephone Company, additional protective equipment is required to prevent such interference or impairment, such equipment shall be provided by the subscriber or by the Telephone Company at the subscriber's expense.
B.	Subscriber-owned equipment and the power supply to which it is connected shall be of such character and so located as to avoid injury to the public or Telephone Company employees, or damage to Telephone Company plant or services.
