## **SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 4 (Cont'd.)**

### **SPECIAL PROVISIONS: (Cont'd.)**

- h. For each electrical point of connection of the customer's facilities to the Company's facilities, the customer will be responsible for all applicable costs.

Subsequent reconnections and disconnections including any pursuant to Special Provisions l.b, l.g and 3.a shall be at cost.

At its own expense, upon 30 days' written notice from Company or joint-owner (except that where such 30 day notice is not possible as much notice as is possible will be given), relocate or replace its facilities, or transfer them to substituted poles, or perform any other work in connection with said facilities that may be required by Company or joint-owner in the maintenance, replacement, removal or relocation of said poles. In cases of emergency, Company or joint-owner may relocate, replace, remove or transfer customer's facilities and customer shall reimburse Company or joint-owner for the costs and expenses incurred. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Company will endeavor to advise customer of substantial projects as far in advance as possible.

3. The Company and customer agree that:

- a. The applicable customer facilities shall be disconnected by the Company and physically removed by customer within 30 days of termination of all or any part of the service being rendered under this Service Classification.
