2.15 Explanation of Terms (Cont'd)

TOLL CALL

Any call extending beyond the local exchange of the originating caller which is rated on a toll schedule by the Company.

TOLL MESSAGE

A message between stations in different exchange areas and furnished under the provisions of the applicable toll tariff.

PERSON TO PERSON TOLL MESSAGE

A toll message in which the user stipulates a desire for communications with a specified person or extension station at a specified location.

STATION-TO-STATION TOLL MESSAGE

A toll message in which the user stipulates a desire for communication only with a specified telephone or switchboard.

COLLECT MESSAGE

A toll message in which the user stipulates that the called party accept and pay all charges associated with the message.

THIRD NUMBER MESSAGE

A toll message in which associated charges are billed neither to the calling station nor to the called station, but rather to a station not involved in the message.

CREDIT CARD MESSAGE

A toll message in which associated charges are billed to a credit card number assigned by a telephone Company and issued to either the called or calling party.

TOLL RATE

The initial period charge prescribed for toll message usually based upon a minimum initial period and distance between changes.
