Section 6 - Business Services (cont'd)

6.5. Local Exchange Service Areas

The Telephone Company will provide local exchange service to business customers in the same exchanges as residential customers where technically feasible. The local calling area will be the same as residential customers. The exchanges and local calling areas are in accordance with Section 3 Local Service, of this tariff.

6.6. Application of Business Service

Business Services apply at the following locations:

- 6.6.1. In offices, stores, factories and all other places of a strictly business nature
- 6.6.2. In offices of hotels, halls and offices of apartment buildings, quarters occupied by clubs or lodges, public, private or parochial schools or colleges, hospitals, libraries, churches and other similar institutions, except churches and boarding houses as specified below.

At residence locations when use of the service either by the customer, members or his household, his guests or parties calling him can be considered as more of a business than of a residence nature, which might be indicated via advertising, business cards, newspapers, handbills, circular, etc.
- 6.6.3. At residence locations, where the service or an extension line is located in a shop, office or other place of business
- 6.6.4. In college fraternity houses where the members lodge within the premises
- 6.6.5. Any location where the listing of service at that location indicates a business, trade or profession.
